Dr. Aaron Fisher – Is affiliated with the La Vie Counseling Center of Santa Monica and Pasadena and received his Master of Arts in Clinical Psychology and Doctor of Clinical Psychology from Wheaton College, Wheaton IL. His broad experience includes working with homeless men at Union Rescue Mission on Skid Row, Lazarus Homeless Shelter, children and adolescents with trauma histories in foster care, conducting court ordered psychological evaluations, and therapeutic counseling with individuals, couples and families.
