Featured Topic: A Different Kind of Housing Option: Safe Parking

As of the Homeless Count last January, 15,700 persons were living in their vehicles each night. These vehicle dwellers represent over 25% of the population of people experiencing homelessness in LA County.



The mission of Safe Parking LA is to provide safe parking options for all homeless individuals living in their vehicles.

Come hear co-founder and Executive Director of Safe Parking LA Dr. Scott Sale discuss how his group is working to provide these individuals a safe place to park each night while they strive to find housing.



Dr. Sale, an internist specializing in allergy and Immunology worked with a number of organizations helping the homeless for over ten years prior to founding Safe Parking LA.
